TIPS FROM THE GREEN TEAM!

The Green Team now has a bulletin board in the hallway. **Anyone interested in helping with the Pollinator Garden please look for more information there and sign up to help. We will need help watering and weeding throughout the summer."**

May Green Tips:

-Appreciate water! Droughts, pollution and accessibility elsewhere make potable water scarce. As we go into summer and the water-table lowers, remember to turn off the tap when not actively in use. Avoid lawn watering in the middle of the day (10am - 4pm) when it is the LEAST effective. Put a clock or timer in your bathroom to help keep shower usage reasonable. Pour buckets of cleaning water on your lawn or down the indoor drain where it will get filtered; pouring it into the street drain sometimes puts that soap directly into local wildlife water.
