Leon Rubinstein is the guest speaker. He's a Holocaust survivor and author of *As I Am Presently Known*. Leon was born in Poland in 1930. He lost his home, his parents and most of his family to the Nazi invasion when he was a child. Surviving the war against all odds literally hiding in a hole for two years — he was smuggled into British Palestine on the cusp of Israel's Warof Independence in 1948. Through the discovery of an uncle in America, Leon immigrated and began a new life in the Boston area. Everyone is invited to join this important and moving service. We will remember the horrors of the Holocaust and recommit to never, ever, allowing such atrocities to happen again. All are welcome, but please use discretion when deciding whether to bring children.
