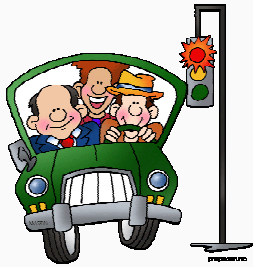
You can help out Team Awesome by renting a kid. If you rent a kid, a member of Team Awesome will do household chores for you in return for funding for the mission trip.

SOLAR POWER FOR OUR CHURCH-UPDATE!

The Team Solar Light of Christ is pleased to report that we have signed a Power Purchase

Agreement with Revision Energy. All terms are exactly as promised. In summary:

- UCC will be re-roofing the sections of roof prior to panel install and plans to re-wire the meters to maximize the logistical benefit.
- Revision will install and operate the system for the first 6 years at no cost to UCC.
- UCC will save over \$26k in electric cost over the first 7 years and use those savings to pay for the system in year 7.
- After year 7 UCC will own the system and continue to save \$\$ and continue to do our small part in saving the planet.

We are still targeting Oct 2017 to be operational.
