Loving Kindness Meditation

Those of you who were in worship on Sunday were able to experience our first Loving

Kindness Meditation of the season. All summer long we will begin our services by centering ourselves with this meditation:

May I be well
May I be filled with joy
May I practice loving kindness

As you are all aware, we are in the midst of an extremely challenging time. However, as a people of faith, we can approach this time as an opportunity to explore practices that will more deeply sustain, unite and inspire us. Jesus often went off by himself to rest, restore, refill his cup and renew his relationship with God. Steven Smith of the Center for Contemplative Mind in Society introduced the practice in this way: “We begin with loving ourselves, for unless we have a measure of this unconditional love and acceptance for ourselves, it is difficult to extend it to others. Then we include others who are special to us, and, ultimately, all living things. Gradually, both the visualization and the meditation phrases blend into the actual experience, the feeling of loving kindness.” This practice can deepen our communion with God, with Jesus, with ourselves and each other. We hope you'll join us for worship each Sunday in July and August as we'll offer the meditation to ourselves, then our loved ones, then those we have trouble with, and finally, the whole world.

PEOPLE HELPING PEOPLE AND OUR *RED WAGON!*
