Greetings UCC Burlington!

It was about this time last year when I was writing to say that we wouldn't return to in-

person worship until we could do so safely. It's been a long and incredible year.

Parish Council voted to reopen our beloved sanctuary for in-person worship beginning on Sunday, July 11, 2021. Services will start at 10:30 am and will simultaneously be streamed on Zoom. Recorded services will be posted on our YouTube page.

SOME THINGS TO KNOW

Please leave your mask on for the entirety of the service. There will be parts of the service where you'll be invited to participate and all participation is optional according to your comfort level.

We will have time for coffee and conversation after the service in Sewall Hall. Just go through the doors at the front of the Sanctuary and walk straight down to Sewall Hall.

We will no longer pass the infamous red Friendship Pads. Instead, those of you who are worshipping with us in person have a **Friendship Slip attached to your bulletin.** Please take a moment to fill this out and put it in the basket during the collection of the offering. This will help us keep track of attendance, and, in the very unlikely event of a COVID outbreak, it will help us with contract tracing.

LABYRINTH DEDICATION

Did you know that our church recently purchased a gorgeous 24 ft. canvas labyrinth? This was bought using money from the grant Angela received for her sabbatical. Although she won't be taking her sabbatical, we are still able to keep the labyrinth. Silver lining! **We are going to dedicate our new labyrinth in worship on Sunday, August 1st.** We'll remotely bless it from the sanctuary,



although it will be set up in Sewall Hall. After church, we invite you to walk over to Sewall Hall to take a look at it, and even slip your shoes off and walk it. Going forward, our plan is to use it for special services throughout the year. In addition to the dedication on August 1st, Debbie Claar and Pastor Angela will have a dialogue sermon where they talk about the ritual of walking a labyrinth and how it can add to our spiritual lives. Thank you to Debbie and Chris Stahlinski for their hard work in helping us purchase our new labyrinth. We hope you'll join us on Sunday, August 1st for its dedication and inaugural debut!

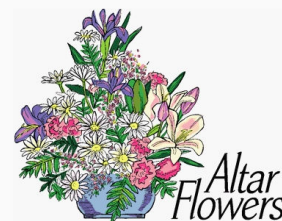
Rides to Church Needed!
