

Dear Congregants,

Now that COVID-19 infection rates are on a steady decline, we welcome you back to inperson worship, Worship service begins at 10:30 am. Live Zoom streaming will continue to be available for those who cannot or who are not ready to join us in person. Choir will resume on March 13th.

To protect the welfare of ALL participants, we will continue to request that in-person attendees wear masks during service. We will maintain this practice until the weather

begins to warm and we can improve air circulation by opening windows.

In-person Christian Education has resumed. Children should wear their masks, too. **We will not have Coffee Hour during March** – this gives us time to confirm that COVID-19 infection rates remain low, and it gives us time to seek Coffee Hour Host volunteers.

Deacons will meet again on April 5th and at that time we will review local COVID-19 infection rates. We anticipate resuming Coffee Hour on April 10th, Palm Sunday.




Children's Choir


EASTER FLOWERS FOR WORSHIP!

The 1st movie is: The Men Who Stare at Goats

It is a 2009 <u>satirical dark comedy war film</u> starring <u>George Clooney</u>, <u>Ewan McGregor</u>, <u>Jeff Bridges</u>, and <u>Kevin Spacey</u>. It was produced by Clooney's and Heslov's production company <u>Smokehouse Pictures</u>. The film is a fictionalized version of <u>Jon Ronson</u>'s <u>2004</u> <u>book of the same title</u> of an investigation into attempts by the U.S. military to employ psychic powers as a weapon—which, in turn, is a companion to a British miniseries Crazy Rulers of the World.
