### GREEN TEAM TIPS

The town of Burlington has instituted the 2nd step water restrictions effective back on May 1st in order to keep the town water above the recommended minimum level. Essentially, only 'night' watering allowed for established plantings, (which is when the water usage is most efficient). Decorative plants, containers etc. can still be watered by hand at any time, but even this is most efficient before 10am or after 4 pm.
