## GUN BUY-BACK PROGRAM BURLINGTON POLICE DEPARTMENT

**Saturday, May 19 9 a.m. to 1 p.m**  
**Burlington Police Department Garage,**  
**45 Center Street**

The Burlington Police Department will offer residents a safe way to dispose of unwanted firearms. Those who do submit firearms will receive a \$25 gift card to Wegmans in exchange for each one they turn in. Airsoft or BB guns may also be turned in, but owners of those items will not be compensated for doing so.

Officers will also be available during the event to retrieve firearms from the homes of residents who wish to surrender them but are unable to attend in person. All guns that are turned in will be safely destroyed.

"This is an excellent opportunity for residents to remove unwanted firearms from their home and feel confident that they won't fall into the wrong hands," Chief Kent said. "I encourage anyone who is interested in surrendering their unwanted firearms to do so at this event, and I want to thank our partner agencies and Wegmans for making this possible."
