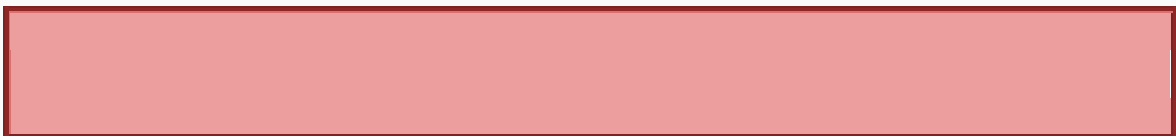

The Pantry is located at 1 St. Mark's Road, Burlington. There is a storage bin on site to drop off donations.

For the second week in a row, the Pantry not been able to get an appointment at the Greater Boston Food Bank. As you know our numbers are up at least 30% since COVID-19. In April we supported a record of 201 families, and we continue to sign up new families every week. **We are extremely low on the following items:**

canned tomatoes **pasta sauce**
broth **jelly**
flour and sugar **dish soap**
canned vegetables
(except corn and green beans)
