In-gathering is the official end to the Finance and Stewardship season...but it really isn't. The campaign isn't over until we have the funds and volunteer commitments needed to fulfill our missions for the upcoming year.

At this point, we have received 75% of the pledges we expected based on last year's participation. With 25% of the expected pledges outstanding, we are shy of our expected budget needs by 32%.

This year's *Time and Talent Survey* was lighter than we hoped for as well, with far fewer people submitting a time and talent form than in prior years. Three areas that are in extreme need of volunteers are: Finance and Stewardship (F&S), Trustees and Clerk. On In-gathering Sunday, I promised \$100 donations for each person that signed up for F&S, Trustees or HR Committees. We had one volunteer come forward for the HR Committee. I renewed the challenge, but am adding the Church Clerk role to that offer. (You volunteer your time, and I'll provide additional funds to help the budget. Win-Win!)

Please consider what contributions you are able to make to the church this year, both in time and in funds. We need your support to keep the missions of this church blooming. If you want to learn more about any committee or role, please reach out to a committee member or contact Michael Lewis.
